

# Community Nursing Clinics


Community Nursing Clinics specialize in providing a variety of nursing services including wound care, intravenous therapy and catheter care. Clinics are staffed with highly qualified teams of health professionals providing care in a clean, controlled environment.


Through an assessment, your Care Coordinator will determine if your care can be delivered in a Community Nursing Clinic. If your needs can be safely met, you will be welcomed in a clinic convenient to you.


Nurses at the clinic will design your care plan to best meet your health care goals. Service plans are developed to promote independence, and we will work to support you in managing your own ongoing care if deemed safe and appropriate.

The clinics allow for independence and flexibility; instead of waiting at home, you can arrange for required nursing care at a convenient date, time and location, allowing you to design a care schedule best suited to your personal needs.



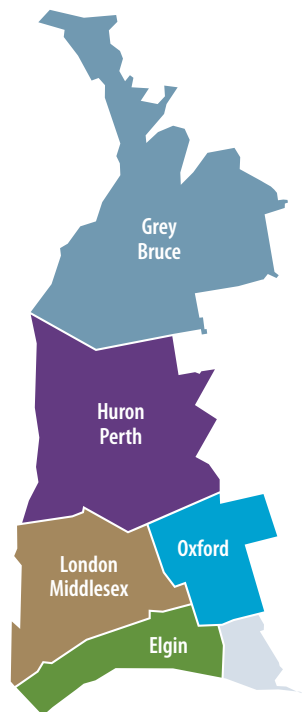
 Visits to a Community Nursing Clinic are by **appointment only** and are **not** the same as visiting a walk-in medical clinic.

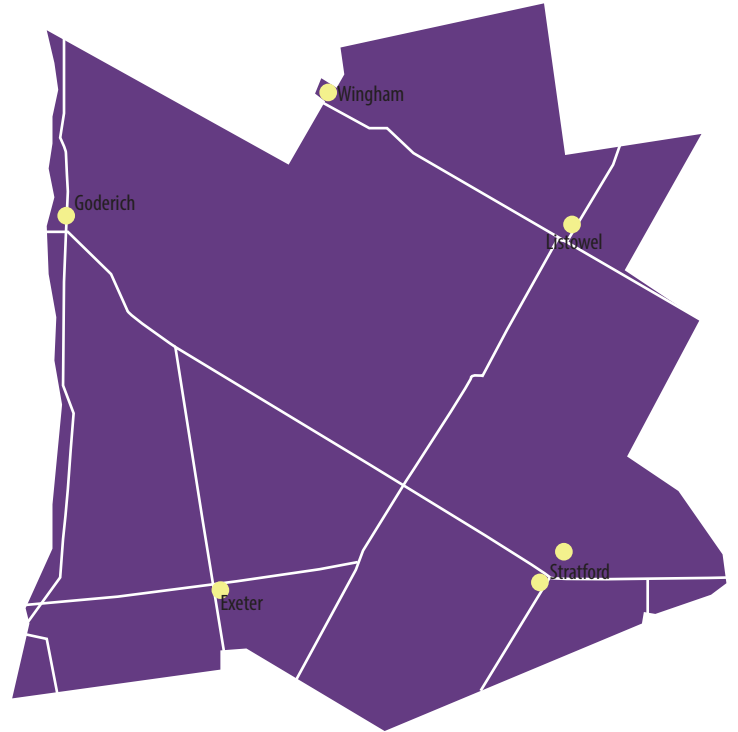

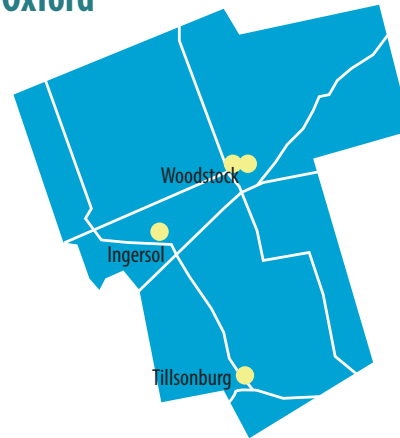
